



Hudson Bay Railway Three Year Plan

HBR's three-year rail network plan indicates where on our lines we intend to take steps to discontinue operations in the next three years. This plan is kept up to date and indicates for each of our lines our intent to continue operations.

Pursuant to Section 141 of the Canada Transportation Act, Hudson Bay Railway (HBR) has updated its Three-year rail network plan.

The plan consists of two schedules:

Schedule A is a comprehensive list of those lines on which, within the next three years, HBR intends to take steps to discontinue operations.

Schedule B is comprised of a map, including a graphical illustration of HBR's rail network and to provide general information only about HBR's Network Plan. A line designated as "to discontinue" means that HBR intends to discontinue operating the line if it is not transferred.
